


(xi)  +  = $2 \text{ tens and } 9 \text{ ones} = 29$ or Twenty-nine

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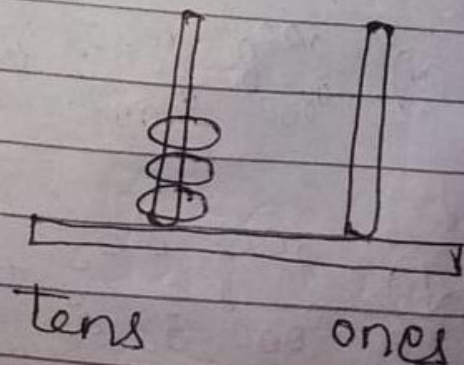
* Now, draw beads to show the numbers.
