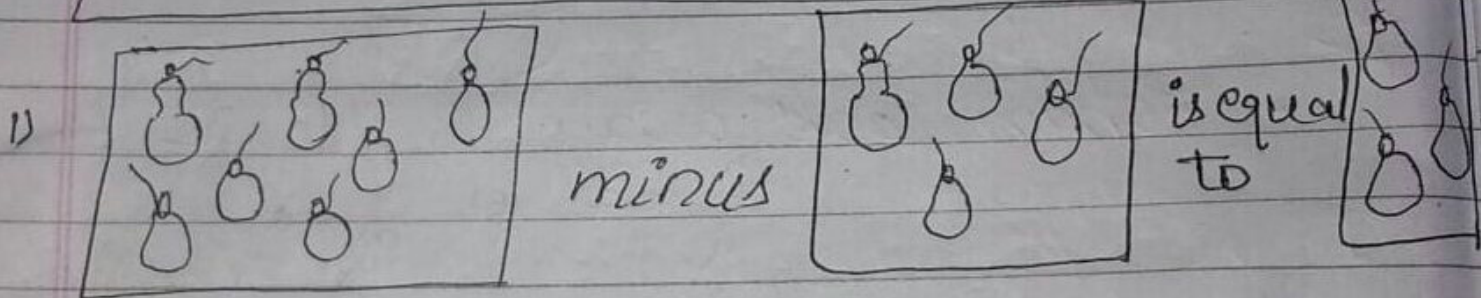

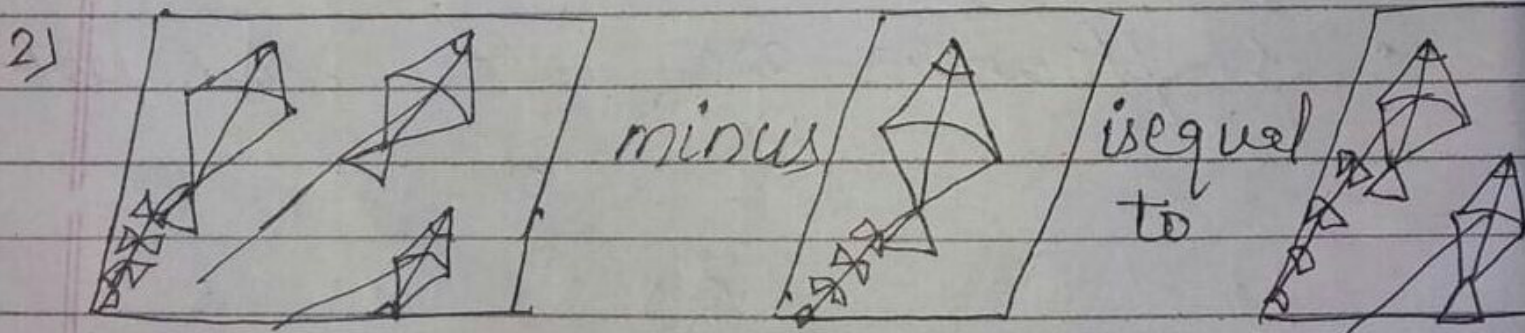
## ★ The Subtraction Symbol

- We use the sign '—' to show that we are subtracting. '—' stands for subtraction, we call it 'minus'.

(a) Count and write. Use '—' in place of 'minus'. Use '=' in place of 'is equal to'.



$$\boxed{7} - \boxed{4} = \boxed{3}$$



$$\boxed{3} - \boxed{1} = \boxed{2}$$
