

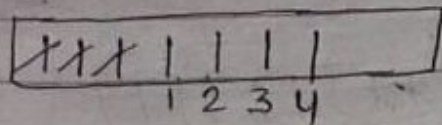

$$\textcircled{3} \quad \boxed{7} - \boxed{3} = \boxed{4}$$



$$\textcircled{4} \quad \begin{array}{r} 8 \\ - 2 \\ \hline \end{array} \quad \boxed{6}$$

### ★ Zero in subtraction

When we subtract 0 from a number, we get the same number.

Or, Example :-

Mini had 5 balls. She gave none to Simi

$$\begin{array}{r} \boxed{5} \\ - \boxed{0} \\ \hline \end{array} = \boxed{5}$$

Mini has 5 balls left with her.

Or, When we subtract a number from itself, we get 0.

Example : Sid had 2 balloons. Both balloons

$$\begin{array}{r} \boxed{2} \\ - \boxed{2} \\ \hline \end{array} = \boxed{0}$$

• Sid has no balloons now.
