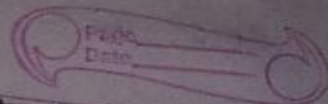

* Subtraction of 3-digit numbers

★ Subtraction without Borrowing.

\Rightarrow Subtraction of 3-digit numbers is similar to that of 2-digit numbers. Let us see how we subtract 3-digit numbers without borrowing.

Let us subtract 328 from 579.

Step 1: First, we arrange the numbers and subtract the ones. $9 - 8 = 1$

Hundreds	Tens	ones
5	7	9
-3	2	8
		1

Step 2: Then, we subtract the tens. $7 - 2 = 5$

Hundreds	Tens	ones
5	7	9
-3	2	8
	5	1

Step 3: Finally, we subtract the hundreds. $5 - 3 = 2$

Hundreds	Tens	ones
5	7	9
-3	2	8
2	5	1

So, $579 - 328 = 251$
