$$3 - 3 = 0$$

Hundreds	Tens	ones
7	3	14
-2	4	4

Expanded form

744 = 7 hundreds 3 tens 14 ones

- 236 = 2 hundreds 3 tens 6 ones

0 tens 8 ones

Step 5: Finally, we subtract the hundreds

Hundreds	Tens	ones
7	3	14
-2	4	4
5	3	6
	0	8

Expanded form

744 = 7 hundreds 3 tens 14 ones

- 236 = 2 hundreds 3 tens 6 ones

5 hundreds 0 tens 8 ones

So, $744 - 236 = 508$
