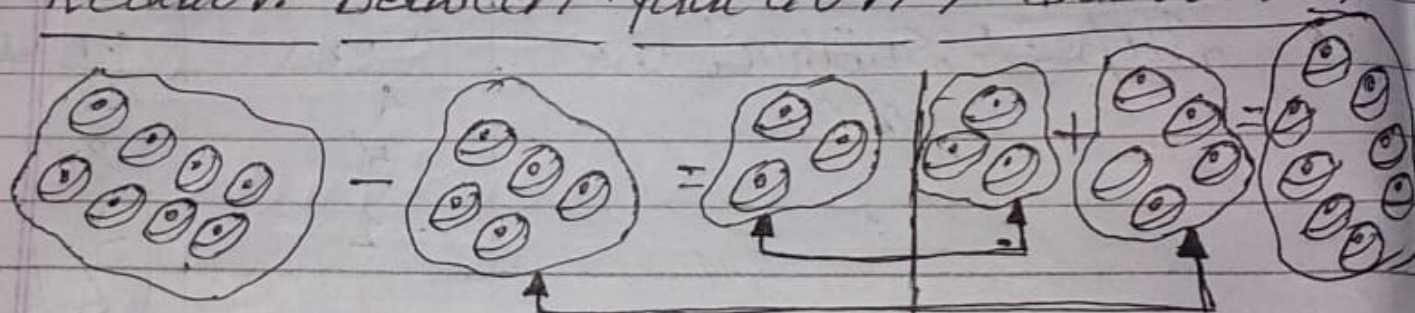

### ★ Relation between Addition & Subtraction



$$\boxed{8} - \boxed{5} = \boxed{3} \quad | \quad \boxed{3} + \boxed{5} = \boxed{8}$$

So,  $8 - 5 = 3 \Rightarrow 3 + 5 = 8$

Or,

addition and subtraction are inverse operations.

For each subtraction fact we can write an addition fact. We use this property to verify our answers for subtraction questions.
