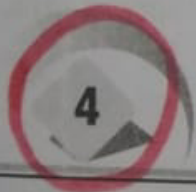
3. Neolithic man realised that mild-natured animals could be domesticated and kept alive till the need for food arose, cattle, sheep and goats could be domesticated.

Food	They discovered certain grasses barley and wheat for food.	Growing crops assured man of a continuous supply of food.
Shelter	They lived in rock-shelters and caves. They made their own houses. Mesolithic man can't stay at one place for long time.	Neolithic man stay at one place for a long time. Hence, permanent human settlements began to be established.
Tools	They were used smaller tools of stones. These tools have stone blades ranging from one to five centimeters in length.	They used harder stones to make tools. They polished the blades to make them sharper & designed to suit his new needs.

2. The families living in a neolithic village were closely related, and shared the same customs, beliefs and methods of worship. The people carried out activities like farming, herding, hunting, gathering and fishing in group. There was division of work, depending mostly on age, wisdom and physical strength.
3. Neolithic Age man changed from a food-gatherer to a food producer. He learnt to take care of the crops he sowed and also reared animals. The crops grown by neolithic farmers from plant remains such as pollen and seeds found in soil deposits of that period.
