4. (i) **Painted Grey Ware** : A type of grey pottery with painted designs known as Painted Grey Ware.
(ii) **Northern Black Polished Ware** : The making of a pottery from fine material, was glossy and very shining is known as Northern Black Polished Ware.
- F. 1. According to the Jatakas the number of families in a village varied from 30 to 1,000. They produce a large quantity of rice and other grains, sugarcane, fruits and vegetables one sixth of that they produced was paid as tax to the king in the form of grains or money.
He used this income for the army, for payment of salaries, for building roads and other welfare activities.
2. The goods produced by the craftspeople were carried over long distances by the merchants. All the important cities were connected to one another by road. Merchants either travelled by carts or sailed down rivers.
Goods traded were textiles, pots, iron tools and ivory objects. They used money i.e., the punch-marked coins earlier in trade.
3. The people of one varna could not eat with those of another varna nor could they marry into another varna. Separate laws were made for the different varnas. So we can say that the varna system became more rigid.
4. (a) Magadha had very ambitious and efficient rulers like Bimbisara and his son Ajatashatru. Bimbisara was to marry princess of some ruling families and expand his territory.
